

Richmond Munster Minor Hockey Association 2009-2010 Registration Instructions

1. Verify information for returning players with pre-printed forms OR Complete blank form for new registrants found on the Administration page on the RMMHA
2. Sign and date registration form
3. Provide all required cheques as summarized below – Registration will **not** be accepted unless all required cheques are included.
4. Send in your form and cheques - check RMMHA website for registration dates (usually June and August) OR mail to RMMHA Registrar, PO Box 1303, Richmond, ON K0A 2Z0
5. Visit www.rmmha.ca to get first ice times and sign up on the web site for email alerts and updates – *Approx. September 24.*

Fundraising

Continuing with the fundraising initiative as recent years, a fundraising cheque in the amount of \$50 per family covers raffle tickets which you can sell to recoup the amount paid.

Canteen Duty Options Per Registered Player

1. Nine hours of canteen shifts. Deposit cheque of \$100 per player will be cashed if missed.
2. OR Canteen buy-out of \$90 per player which will exempt you from Canteen duty.

Competitive Hopefuls

All players trying for competitive teams must register with the RMMHA (home association). If they make a competitive team, players will be exempted from canteen responsibilities, and families with only competitive players will be exempted from fundraising. Families with both House league and competitive players will have to pay fundraising Fee.

Proof of Age and Occupancy

New players must include a copy of birth certificate as proof of age. Proof of occupancy will be required for new registrants (new to minor hockey) and to demonstrate change of address. In addition, players who have moved to the RMMHA area but who played previously in another minor hockey association must also complete a Declaration of Residency Form, available from the registrar.

Equipment

One \$100 cheque per player dated April 1, 2010 will be cashed only if loaned equipment such as team jersey is not returned.
