House League “levels”

In House League, levels are not split by Minor or Major; they are based on skill level. It is quite common to have younger and older children on the same team. For instance, at Atom A, you may have both 9 and 10 year olds on the team. Currently, the only exception to this is Midget – where we have a “Minor Midget” for the younger group, and Midget A, and/or B Teams for the older group.

Our team levels (eg A, B, C) are dictated by the number of registrants, and League rules – therefore not all levels will necessarily be offered at all groups every year (for instance Bantam may not have a “C” if we don’t have enough registered players).

There are very strict rules (or formulas) dictated by District 4 and Lanark Carleton Minor Hockey League on how teams within House League are established....these have been established to ensure that all League associations play by the same rules and have similar competitive levels
